

Age-Friendly Cities is a comprehensive effort to prepare cities around the world for the increasing older adult populations.

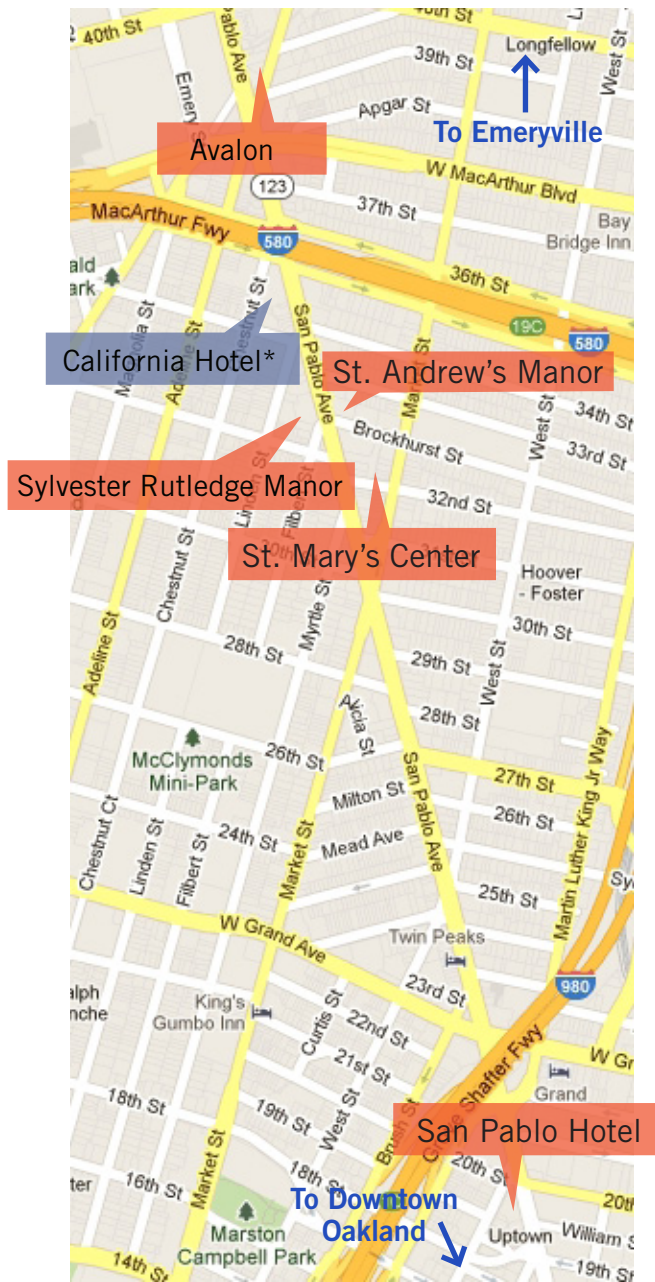
