Advance Child Tax Credit

Do you qualify?

The Advance Child Tax Credit are advance monthly payments to parents who have a qualifying child under the age of 17 beginning July 15th. Families with children ages 5 and younger may receive up to \$3,600 and children ages 6 to 17 may receive up to \$3,000. The income limits are \$150,000 for married filing joints or qualified widower, \$112,500 for head of household, and \$75,000 for single filers.

In order to receive the Advance Child Tax Credit you must either file a 2019 or 2020 tax return or use the IRS non-filer tool. Package Handler Benefits at a Glance

Medical, Dental and Vision - Eligible after 1,000 hours

*FT Package Handlers will be eligible for Medical, Dental and Vision after 90 days.

Tuition Reimbursement - \$5,250/Year - Eligible immediately

PaidTime Off (vacation, sick, personal reasons) – Eligibility based on Full/Part Time status and state laws.
